GUIDELINES FOR PAPER & POSTER

- Abstracts of paper and poster should be in IMRD (Introduction, Methods, and Results & Discussion) format with a word format in font style of Times New Roman, Font size 12, Line spacing 1.5 and max. Word limits 250
- Send abstracts to sinnindia2020@gmail.com. The mail should include a covering letter showing the membership (SINN) status, full name, qualification, designation contact number and e mail id and a self declaration stating that this abstract is not being presented or published elsewhere and study has been done within past five years.
- The submissions without compliance to guidelines will be rejected without prior intimation.
- Acceptance letter will be issued in second week of November
